The PAC is designed to ensure that the parents are provided with an opportunity to ask questions, express concerns and share suggestions to KUCCC. This allows parents to have a voice in the decision making process for the childcare they are paying for. It also helps KUCCC gain a fresh perspective and listen to concerns it might not otherwise hear.

What is a Parent Advisory Committee

Kenesaw United Child Care Coalition is forming a PAC - Parent Advisory Committee. Meetings are held every quarter, where parents have an opportunity to share their perspectives and offer suggestions. The PAC will also help spearhead small projects around the center.

How is the PAC different from our Board of Directors?

Parents have a primary role in ensuring the well-being and positive developmental experiences of their children. The PAC represents the voice of the parents in the decision making process, whereas the Board of Director's authority is more focused on The Center operations.
